Phase I

Stabilize Post War Situation

1. Establish Law and Order
 - Especially in Baghdad & Other Urban Areas
 - Emerging Threats (Ba'athists; Iranian Sponsored Islamic Extremism)
2. Restore Basic Services
3. Root out Saddamism
 - Deba'athification
 - Dissolve Organizations of Repression

Phase II

Consolidate our Victory (1/2)

1. Revive the Economy: “Iraq is open for business”
 - Liquidity for Population
 - Oil Sales
 - Stimulate Trade
 - Begin Economic Reforms
2. Continue Political Transition
 - Interim Iraqi Administration
 - Constitutional Convention

Phase II

Consolidate our Victory (2/2)

3. Restore Civil Society
 - Municipal and Government Advisory Councils
 - Restore Professional Associations (women's groups, lawyers, doctors, Olympic committee)
4. Reform Security Services
 - Job Programs
 - New Iraqi Corps
 - Police Reforms

Phase III

Toward the New Iraq (1/2)

1. Prioritize Economic Reforms
 - Banking System and Currency
 - Privatization and Foreign Investment
 - Oil Industry (exploitation and use of resources)
 - Begin Phase-out of Subsidiaries
2. Work with Interim Administration
 - Increasing Iraqi Responsibilities for Ministerial Work
 - Councils to Address Broad Issues (education, census, political parties, reconciliation)

Phase III

Toward the New Iraq (2/2)

3. Facilitate Drafting of Constitution
 - Encourage Broad Political Dialogue
 - Provide Discrete Legal Advice
 - Address Legal and Judicial Reform
